

Professor Ghazi Abu-Orabi (Ph.D)

Professor Ghazi Abu-Orabi is the Dean of the Faculty of Law at the University of Jordan since 2010 and before that he was the Dean of the Institute for the Study of Islam in the Contemporary World (ISICW). He obtained his Ph.D in Private Law from the University of Paris 10, France in 1987 and his LLM from Ain Shams University in Cairo, Egypt. Dr. Abu-Orabi is a professor of Civil Law, and has been teaching several courses including the following: Sources of Civil Obligations, Rules of Obligation, Insurance Contracts, Civil and Medical Liability.

Prof. Abu-Orabi has supervised, and participated in the supervision of, many Masters and Doctoral dissertations investigating an array of interesting legal questions; his students have been both national and foreign. Prof. Abu-Orabi has taught in several Arab universities and institutes which include the High Institute for Juridical and Judicial Sciences in Dubai, Sharjah University, United Arab Emirates University, and Al Ain University. He is also a member of several NGOs including the association of Jordanian scientists and a member of the Jordan Society for the Protection of Medical Staff. Prof. Abu-Orabi has published extensively; he is the author of numerous articles, reports, and several books. He is an attorney at law and legal consultant since 1990.
