dominated by the general interest and the manifestation of truth, to the detriment of  
human rights. Effective protection of public safety, during the deprivation of liberty  
before trial, requires the verification by human and technical means, always in  
comparative law. Two words summarize the effects of this control, in these two  
rights, they are unstable and theoretical. The balance to be found between, on the one  
hand, the needs of the investigation to confound the perpetrators of the offence and,  
on the other hand, the protection of the person in custody, is complex and  
fluctuating, sometimes depending on the context of insecurity. French law, without  
offering the absolute panacea of an important legislation on police custody, should  
help guide Jordanian reflection, based on its successes but also its shortcomings,  
towards becoming more formalized in its Code of Criminal Procedure, in the desire  
for an adaptation in conformity with its cultural values.
