## Title and abstract of the doctoral thesis (within 'o words)

International commercial arbitration and State policies in commercial matters: the example of competition law

When it is allowed to an arbitrator to settle disputes considered to be matters of public policies, the issue of his involvement in defending State policies is raised. Taking competition law as an example on these policies, it can be assumed that the arbitrator is involved in defending State competition policies. This study aims at

measuring this involvement which varies depending on the relevant subject matter. It can be observed that the involvement of the arbitrator in defending some State competition policies is real and spontaneous. When it comes to other State competition policies, his involvement is almost formal. In addition, the arbitrator's support of some State competition policies can be hindered by other international norms. Sometimes, the reconciliation of these conflicting norms is possible, at other times it is not. Therefore, the arbitrator is prompted to exclude the application of the relevant competition law. Finally, the involvement of the arbitrator in defending certain State competition policies could be heavily supervised, to such an extent that it is considered a particularistic arbitration.
