### **Short Overview**

A training workshop on Case studies in Cyber-Crimes was organized by FORC local coordinator at the University of Jordan Dr. Lina Shabeeb, the workshop was held at the University of Jordan 3<sup>rd</sup> April, 2019 in cooperation with;

- The Public Prosecutor/ the Judicial Council.
- The Unit for Combating Cyber Crimes/ the Criminal Investigation Department.

Dr. Lina Shabeeb, the local coordinator for FORC project at the University of Jordan, Introduced the students to FORC and the objectives for students training where the training was attended by both law and IT students.

Dr. Amal Abu anzeh, an Assistant Professor at the School of law, gave the students a lecture on the Cyber-crimes in Penal Code and Cyber-Crime Law No. 27 / 2015 with the help of Mrs. Ameera Alqinna who is a practicing lawyer.

A lecture on Criminal investigation and evidence collecting in cyber law cases followed by an open discussion was presented by Major Raed Tarazi from The Unit for Combating Cyber Crimes.

The final session was conducted by Mr. Rami Al-Tarawneh, a Judge and Public Prosecutor, who presented cyber law cases and how they can be referred to courts.

This training was linked with the Legal Clinics (LC) program at the School of Law.

The LC program is delivered each semester for a group of undergraduates, where x-clinicians and postgraduates assist in student training. The program has three phases: education, capacity building and training and raising public awareness.

- In the education phase, student get educated by law professors on the topic, cybercrimes and cyber laws. Then they learn the practical side of the topic by field workers, in this case: the Unit for Cyber-Crimes Combatment and the Criminal Investigation Department, in Jordan the person who works as a Public Prosecutor is a Judge, hence, students get to be informed on both parts, the referral procedure to the judicial system and how the case is heard before a criminal court. Students also get educated on issues relating to private law, especially IP laws, regarding digital transaction and cyber related contracts and legal affairs.





- In the capacity building phase, students get a training on several issues, mainly presentation skills and public speaking skills, they also get trained on time management, body language, power point preparation, adaptation ... etc.
- After the initial training session, students prepare a draft power point presentation on the topic, which is revised several times by the trainers, they also train amongst each other on their presentations, before they are able to go to schools to deliver their presentations.
- In the public awareness phase, students go to public (sometimes private) schools to give public awareness lectures on the topic. The target group in most of the cases are grade 10 pupils. Each semester, LCs conduct 16 to 20 presentation at different public schools all over Jordan, covering even the most remote areas (Mafraq, Aqaba, Tafila, Jerash, Dead Sea, Amman... etc.), in each visit, the LC manager arranges with the Ministry of Education to visit two main schools of the targeted region, one boys school and one girls school.


