Termination of International Trade Contracts and the Authority of the Arbitrator

The purpose of the thesis is to clarify the legal issues related to the termination of international trade contracts and the legal reference to be resorted to if one of the parties of the international trade contract wishes to terminate the international contract as a result of the other party's breach of its contractual obligations.
